Help for women who are victims of violence

Women and men have the same rights in Germany.

Nobody is allowed to control a woman. This applies to everyone living in Germany.


Everybody has the right to a life free from violence. No woman needs to accept violence! The same applies in marriage and in the family.



- · Nobody is allowed to hit another person.
- Nobody can be forced to have sex.
- Nobody can be forced into prostitution.
- · Nobody can be forced to get married.
- Female genital mutilation (female circumcision/ cutting of girls' and women's genitals) is forbidden in Germany.
- Nobody is allowed to threaten a woman or lock her up at home.

If someone does this, they will be punished by law in Germany.

If you experience violence, you can call the police or the telephone helpline - any time day or night. Calls are free.

- You can remain anonymous! No one will find out what your name is.
- The female counsellors are not allowed to tell anyone else what you tell them!
